



„Know before you go“

Noise: Our Paradise Lodge can be reached without a 4x4 vehicle on the very well-developed road 243. This is also used by trucks from time to time, sometimes one can hear them, especially when downshifting. Our good-natured, cuddly Dog Gaya announces every newcomer. Sometimes at night, it may happen that she wants to defend her territory by barking against agoutis and toads. Depending on the season, cicadas give their concerts during the day.

Power supply: As everywhere in Costa Rica, short-term power outages can occur. Mostly the problem is solved very quickly, but having a flashlight at hand never hurts.

Internet: We have in each unit its own Wi-Fi hotspot, the maximum transfer rate is 6 Mbit / second.

Temperature: we have no air conditioning! In our region, temperatures always drop to a comfortable level during the night. On request we provide additional fans. The thermometer never shows below 22 ° C = 72 ° F.

Fauna: We always strive to keep our accommodations and outdoor areas free of insects. All windows have insect screens and the beds have mosquito nets. Food should be kept sealed or in the fridge, otherwise hungry ants will be there quickly.

Water: Hot water is available, for water pressure we have a 2500 liter fresh water tank and a pressure pump.

Wastewater: The wastewater is collected in septic tanks on the property. It is important not to throw paper and waste into the toilet, but to use the rubbish bins provided.

Crime: Violence against people only happens exceptionally in Costa Rica, but you should be careful in Limón and San José. In some areas (eg Manuel Antonio, but also Dominical!) Thefts have been more frequent lately. Like anywhere in the world, DO NOT leave any valuables in the parked car unattended, and generally DO NOT leave any items unattended, eg, backpack on the beach while you go swimming.
